Seale & Associates was retained by the family owners of Caffenio, a leading Mexican coffee roaster and producer, to advise on their long-term strategic relationship with OXXO. Building on prior transactions in 2012 and 2018, the parties were evaluating the next stage of their partnership.

**SEALE & ASSOCIATES’ APPROACH**

Seale guided Caffenio through a multi-phase strategy over more than a decade: first a minority stake sale and supply agreement in 2012, followed by an additional stake sale in 2018, culminating in 2025 with the sale of control to OXXO. The approach ensured trust, alignment, and value creation throughout the process.

**OUTCOME**

The 2025 transaction resulted in OXXO acquiring control of Caffenio, securing supply chain reliability, strengthening category leadership, and positioning Caffenio as FEMSA’s key platform for growth in the ready-to-drink coffee market in Mexico and abroad.

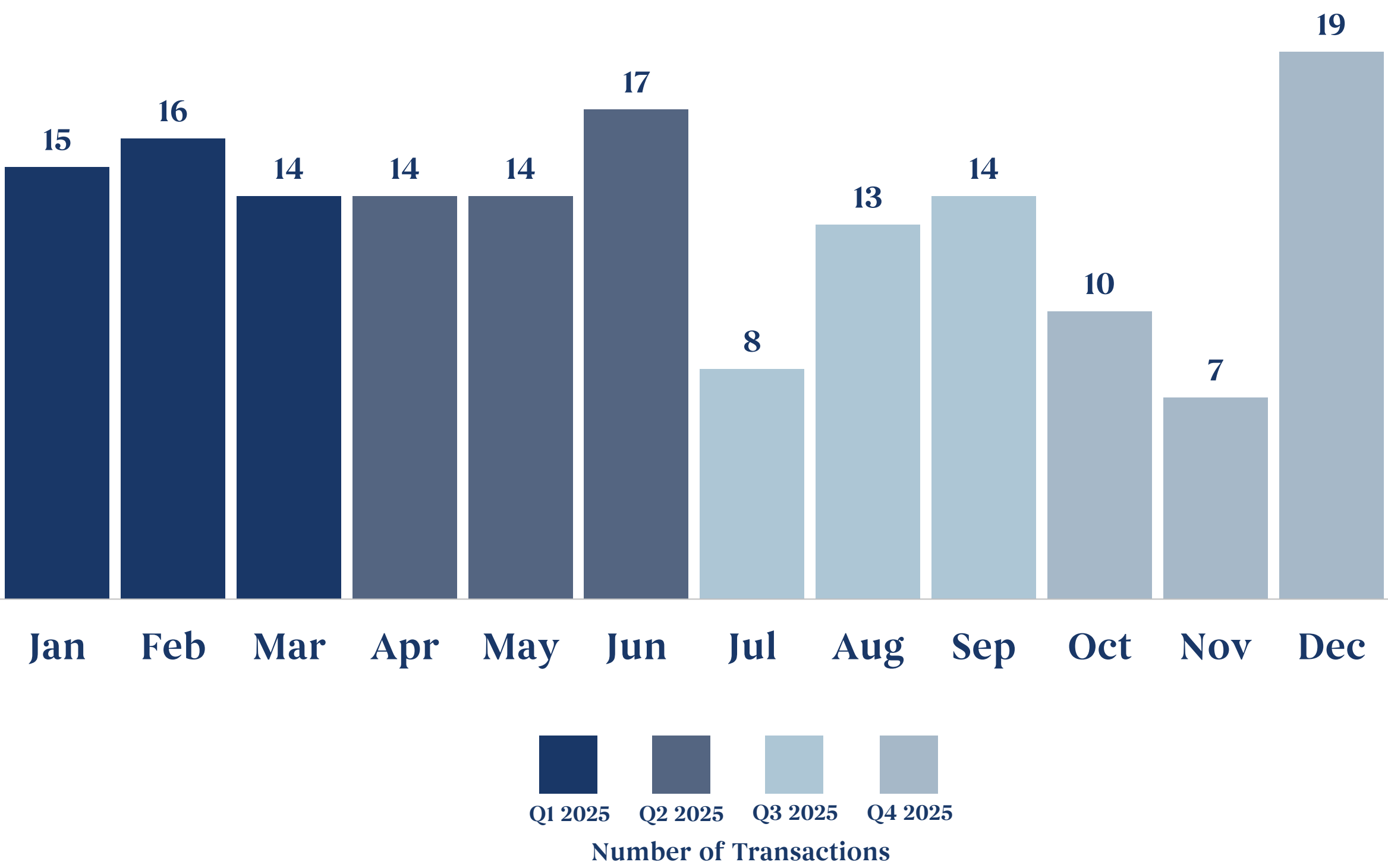

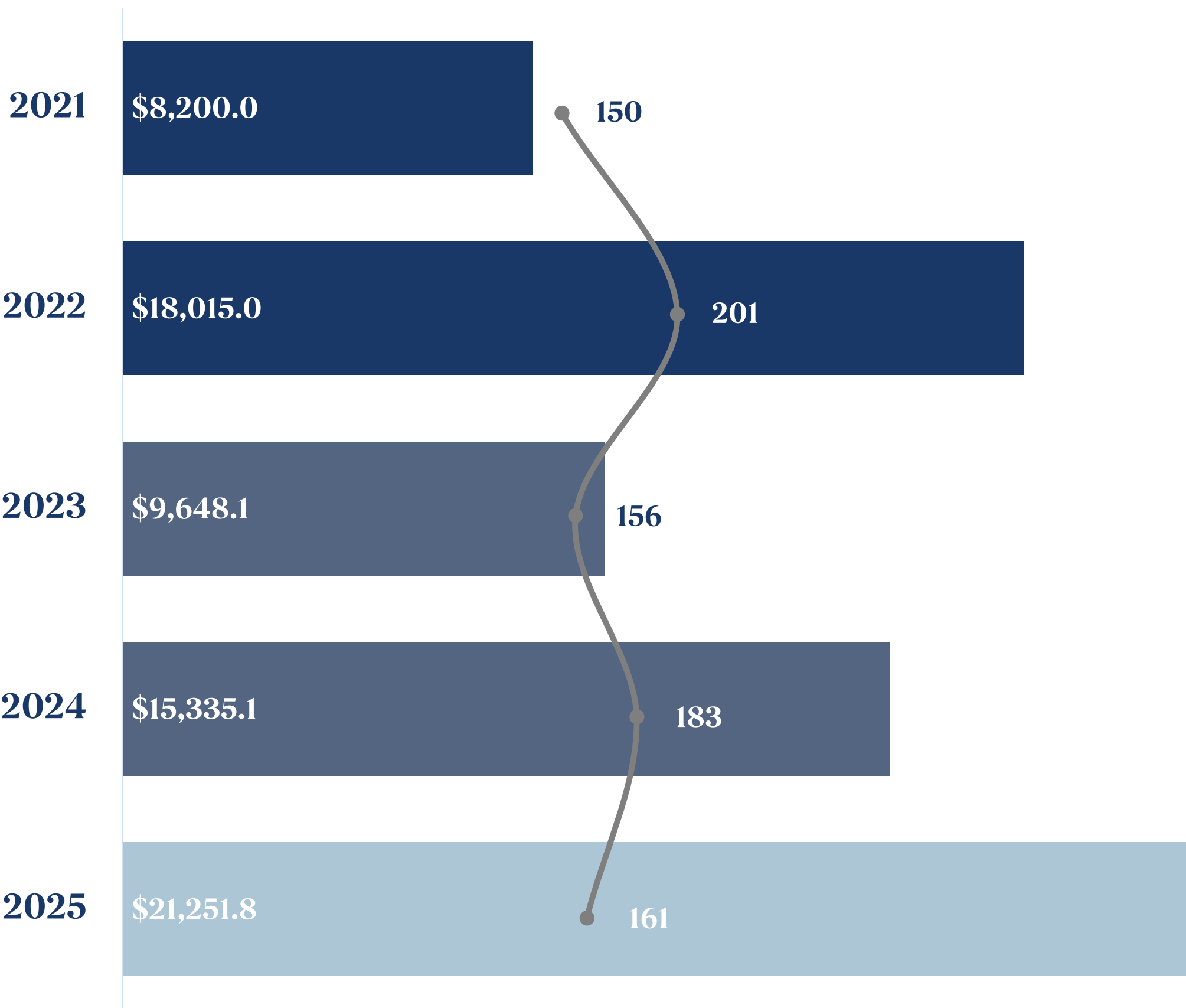
Disclosed Deal Volume in Mexico

Annual Transactions (US\$ million)

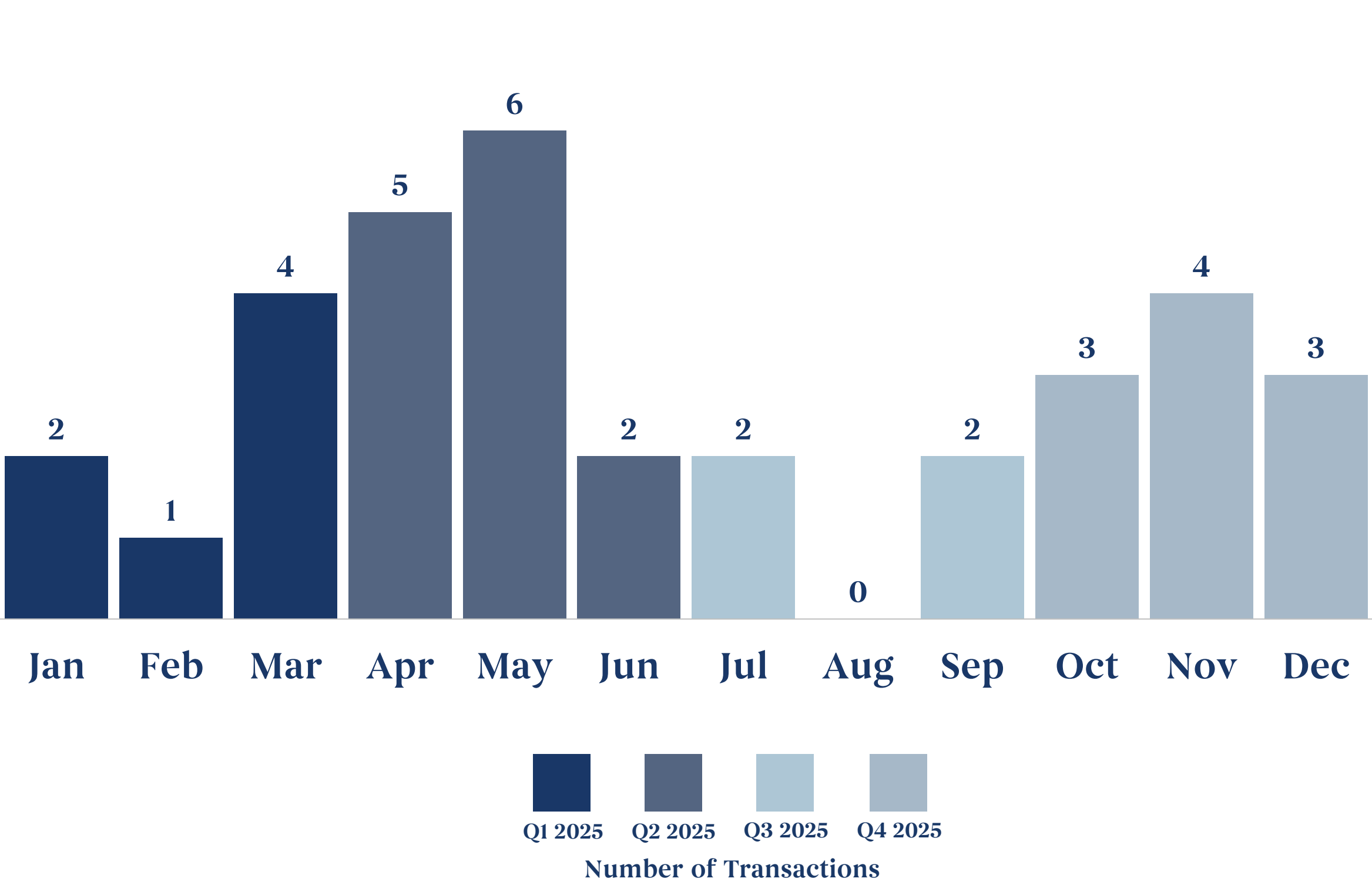




# Summary of Transactions Abroad by Mexican Companies

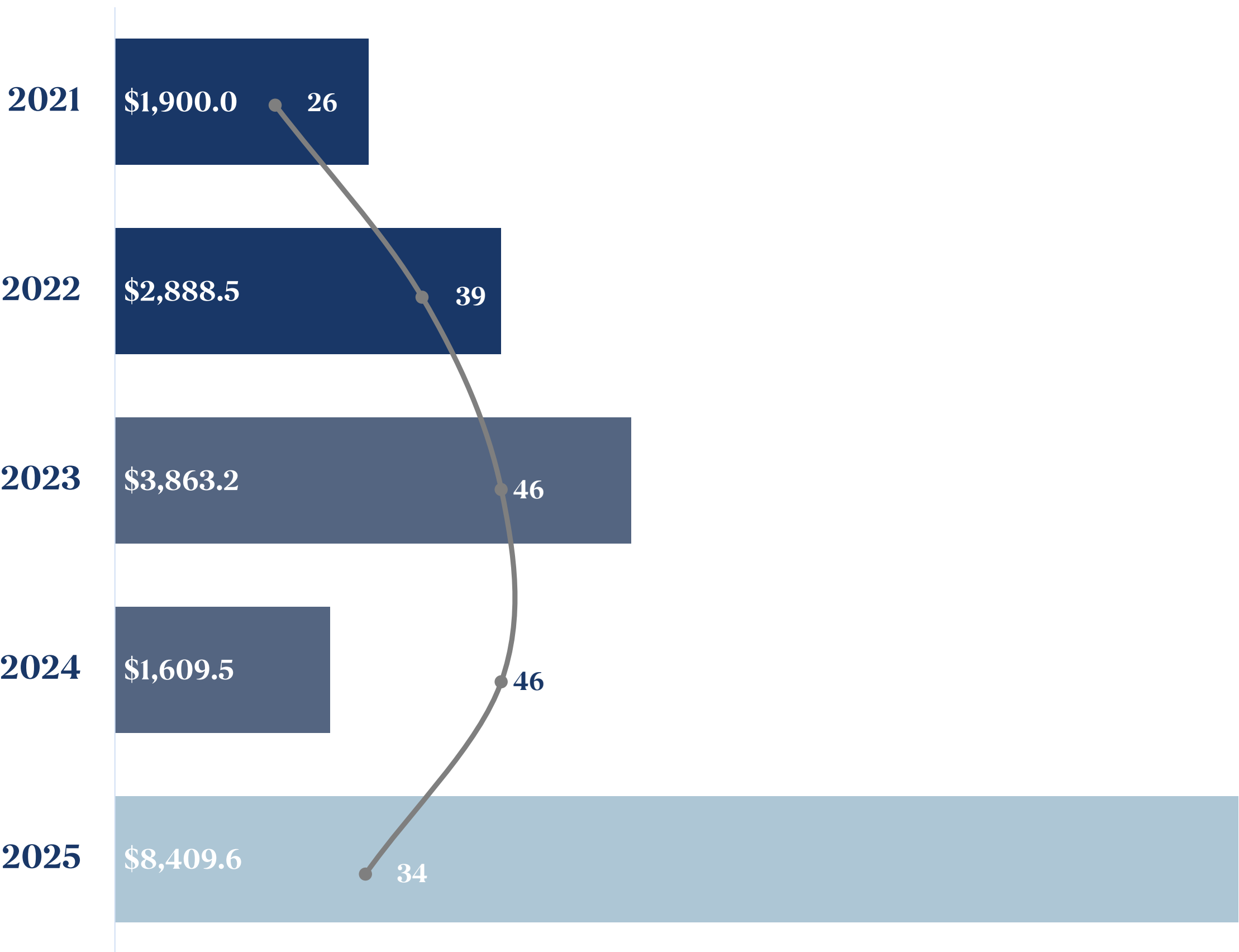
**Disclosed Deal Volume by Mexican Companies Abroad**

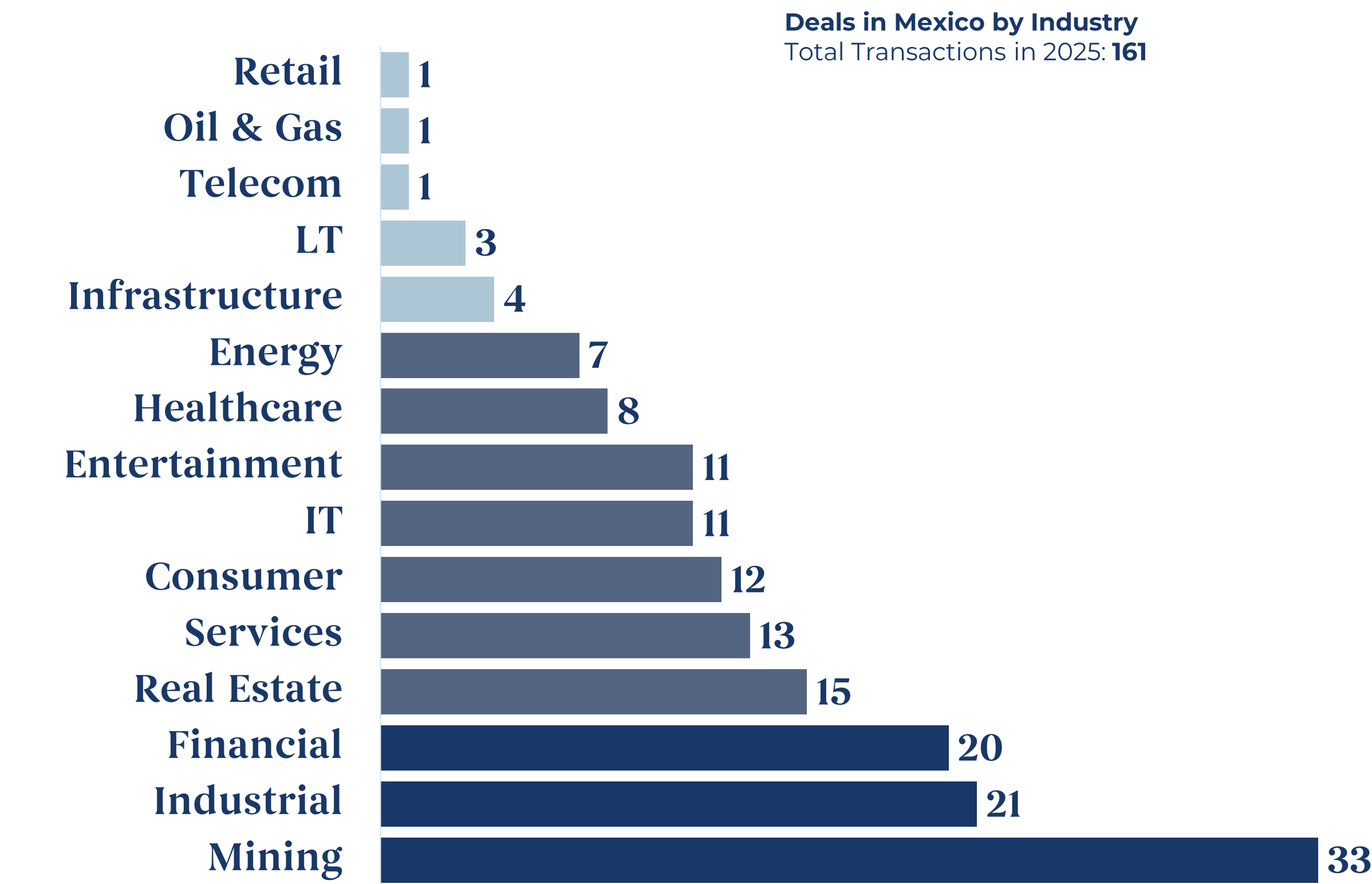
**Disclosed Deal Volume and Value by Mexican Companies Abroad**  
Annual Transactions (US\$ million)



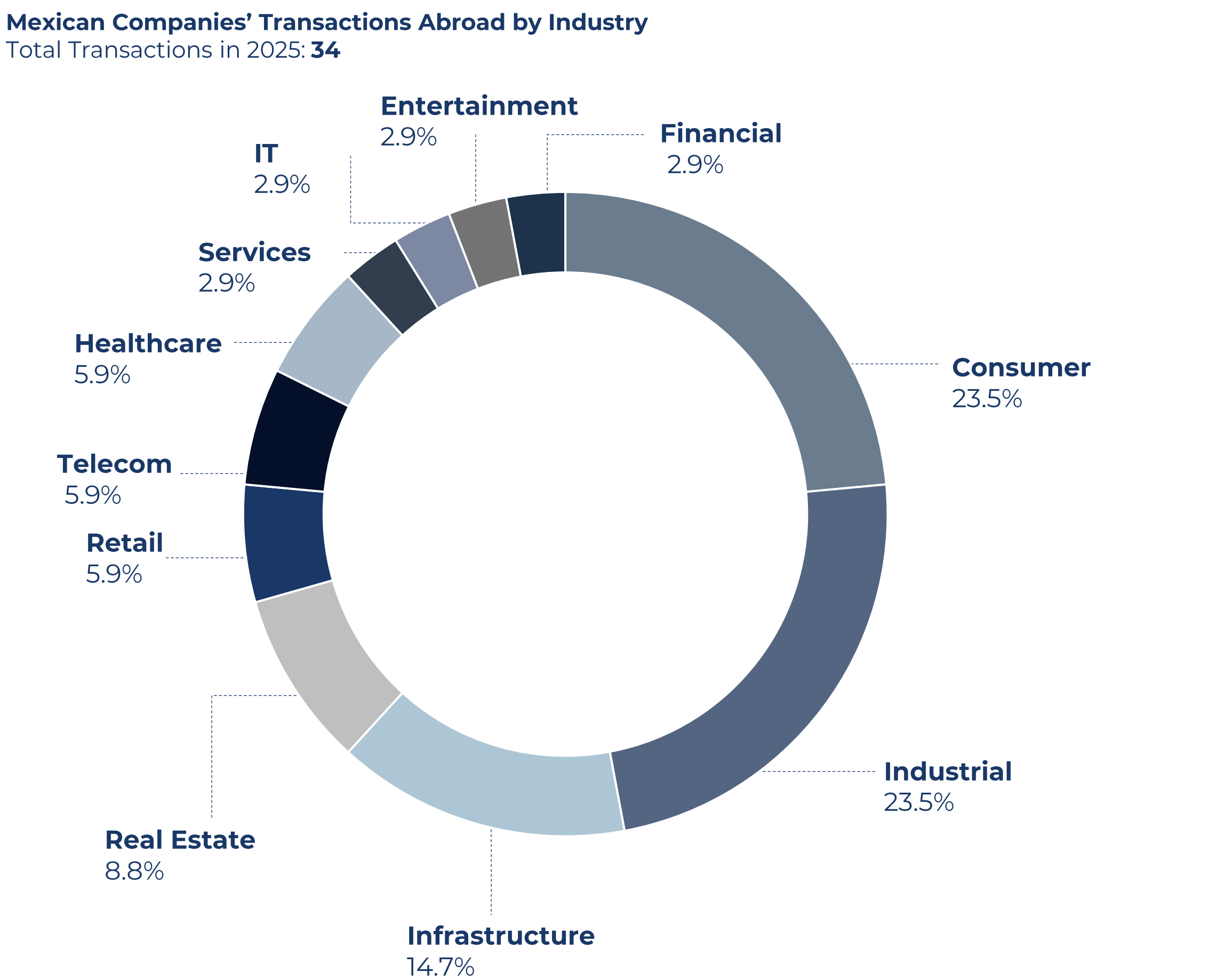


# Summary of Mergers & Acquisitions by Industry

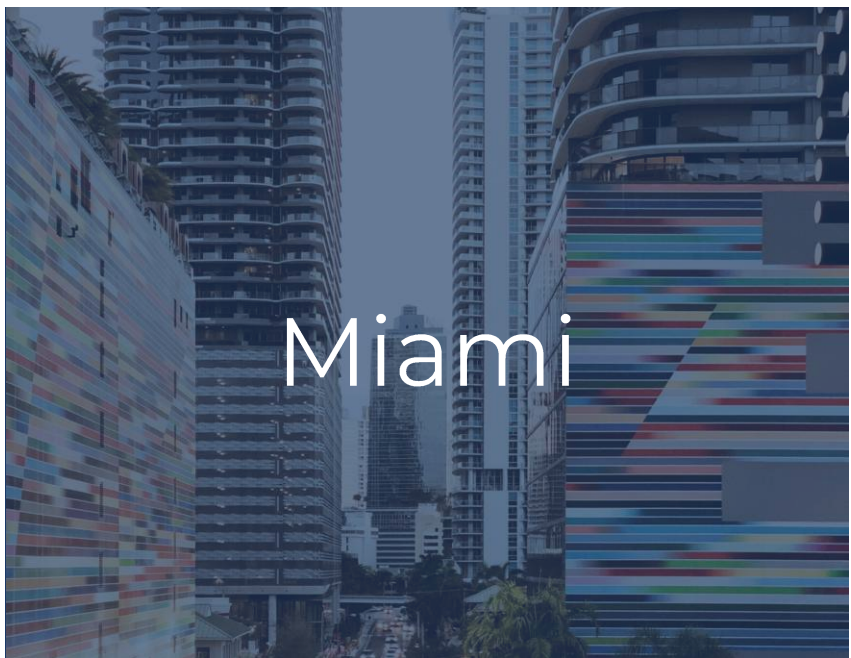

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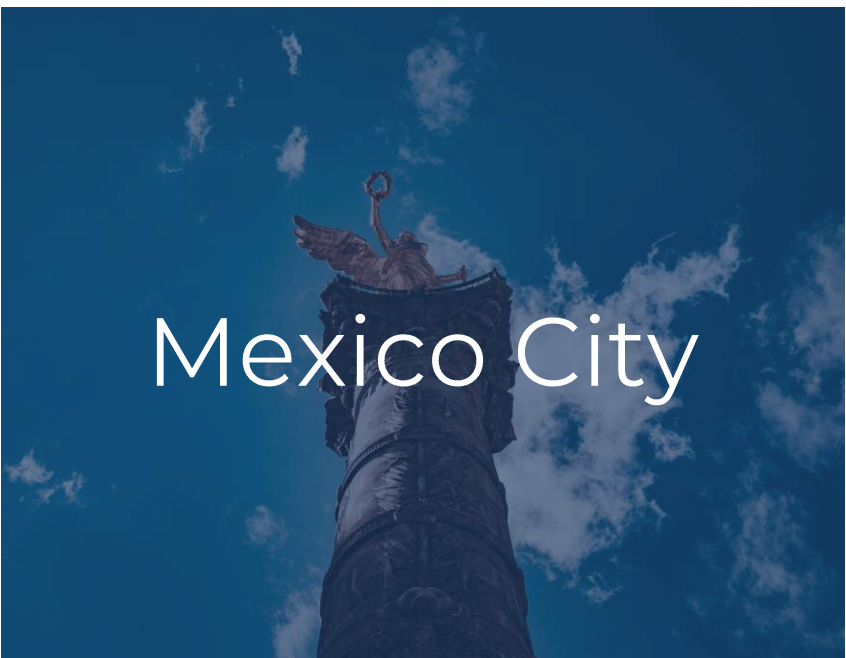
