


Summary of Mergers & Acquisitions in Mexico

In July 2025, **8 transactions** were announced in Mexico, representing a decrease of **9 transactions** compared to the previous month. Compared to the same period last year, the volume of transactions also decreased by **11 transactions**.

of Transactions per Month



Disclosed Deal Volume and Value in Mexico


Annual Transactions (US\$ million)


Disclosed Deal Volume by Mexican Companies in Foreign Geographies# of Transactions per Month



Summary of Mergers & Acquisitions by Industry


The **mining** industry led the domestic M&A activity in Mexico, with **18** announced transactions as of July 2025, representing **18.4%** of the total announced transactions.
