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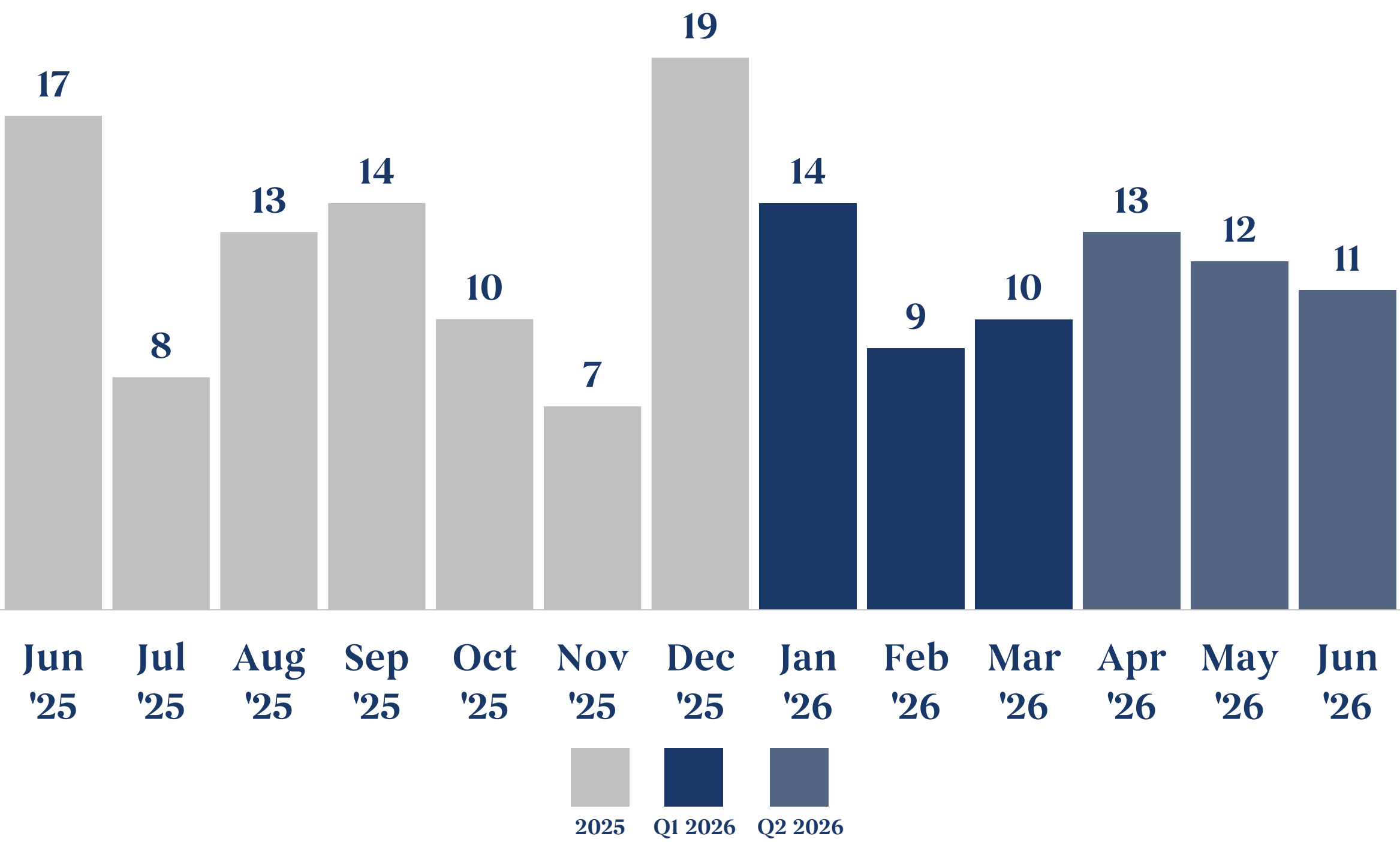

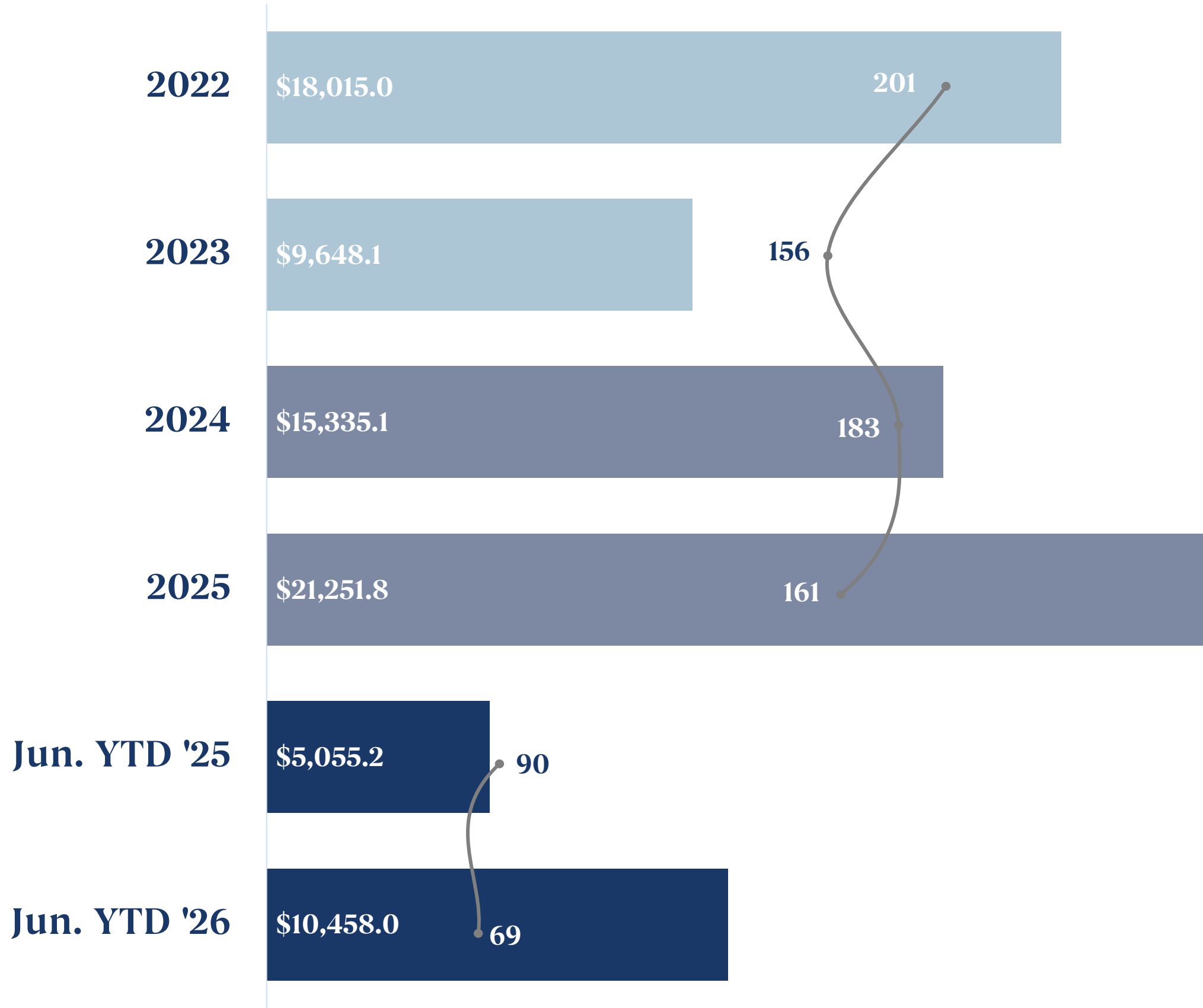
Disclosed Deal Volume in Mexico

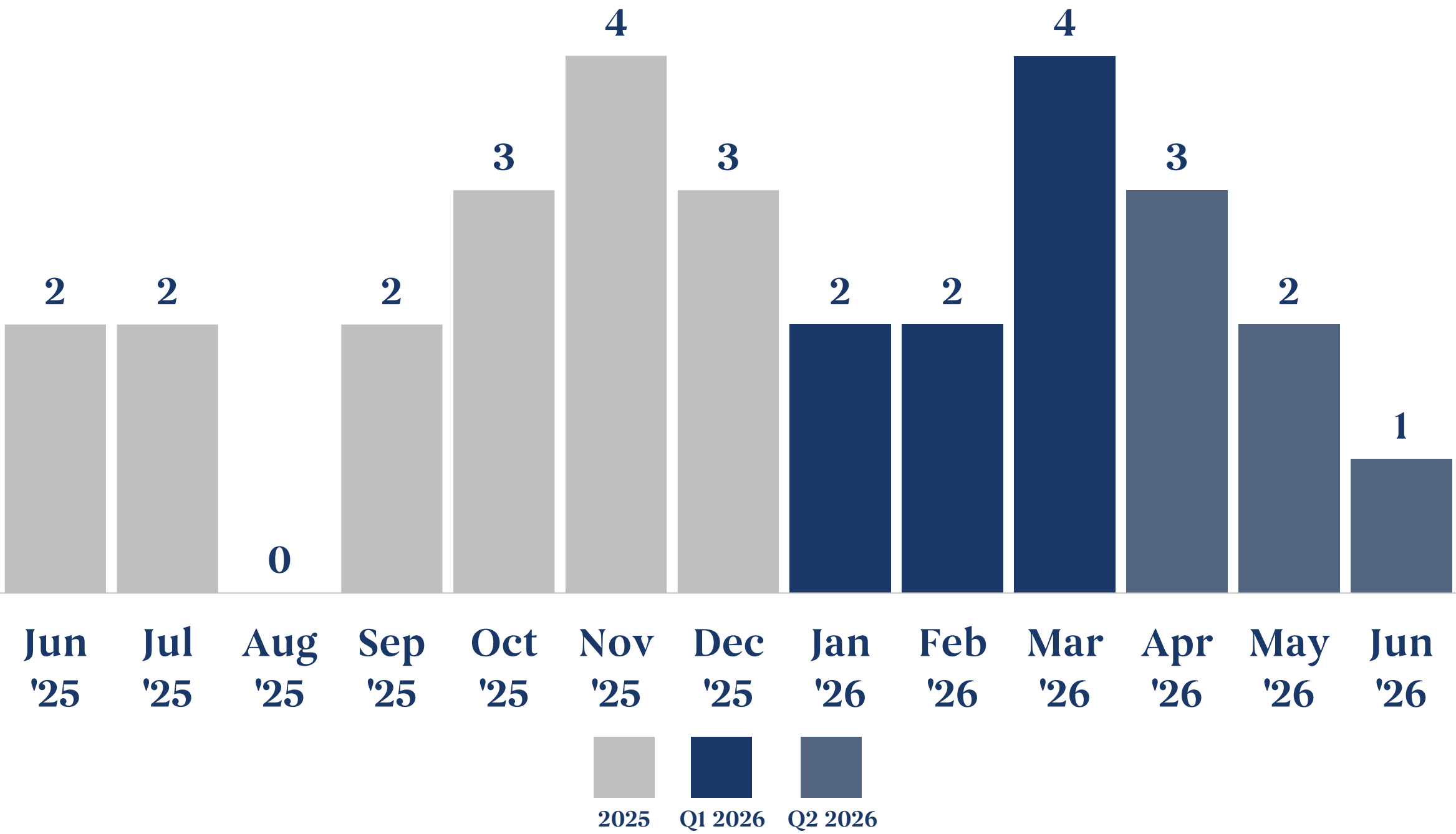
Disclosed Deal Volume and Value in Mexico
Annual Transactions (US\$ million)



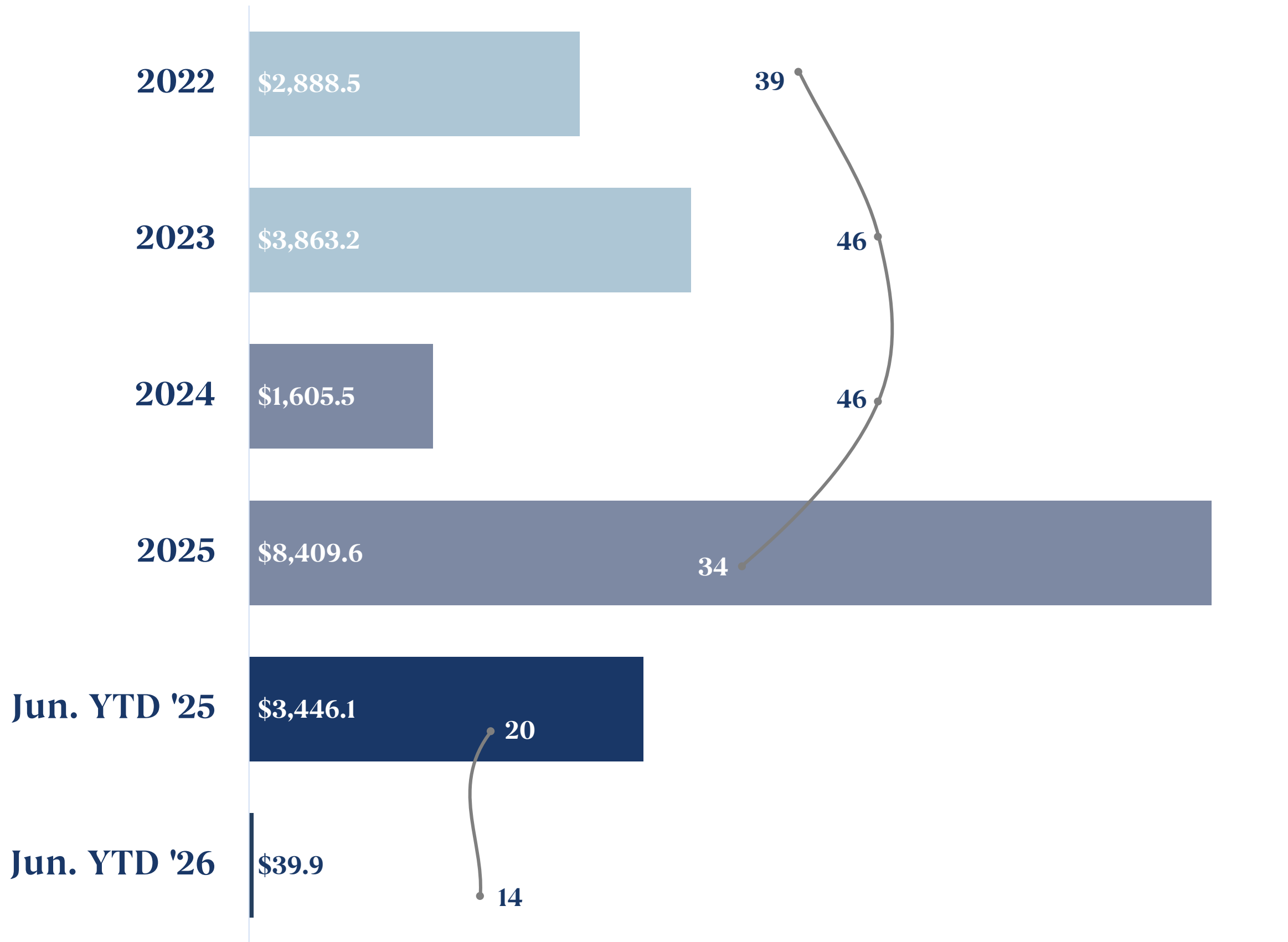
Summary of International Transactions by Mexican Companies

Annual Transactions (US\$ million)

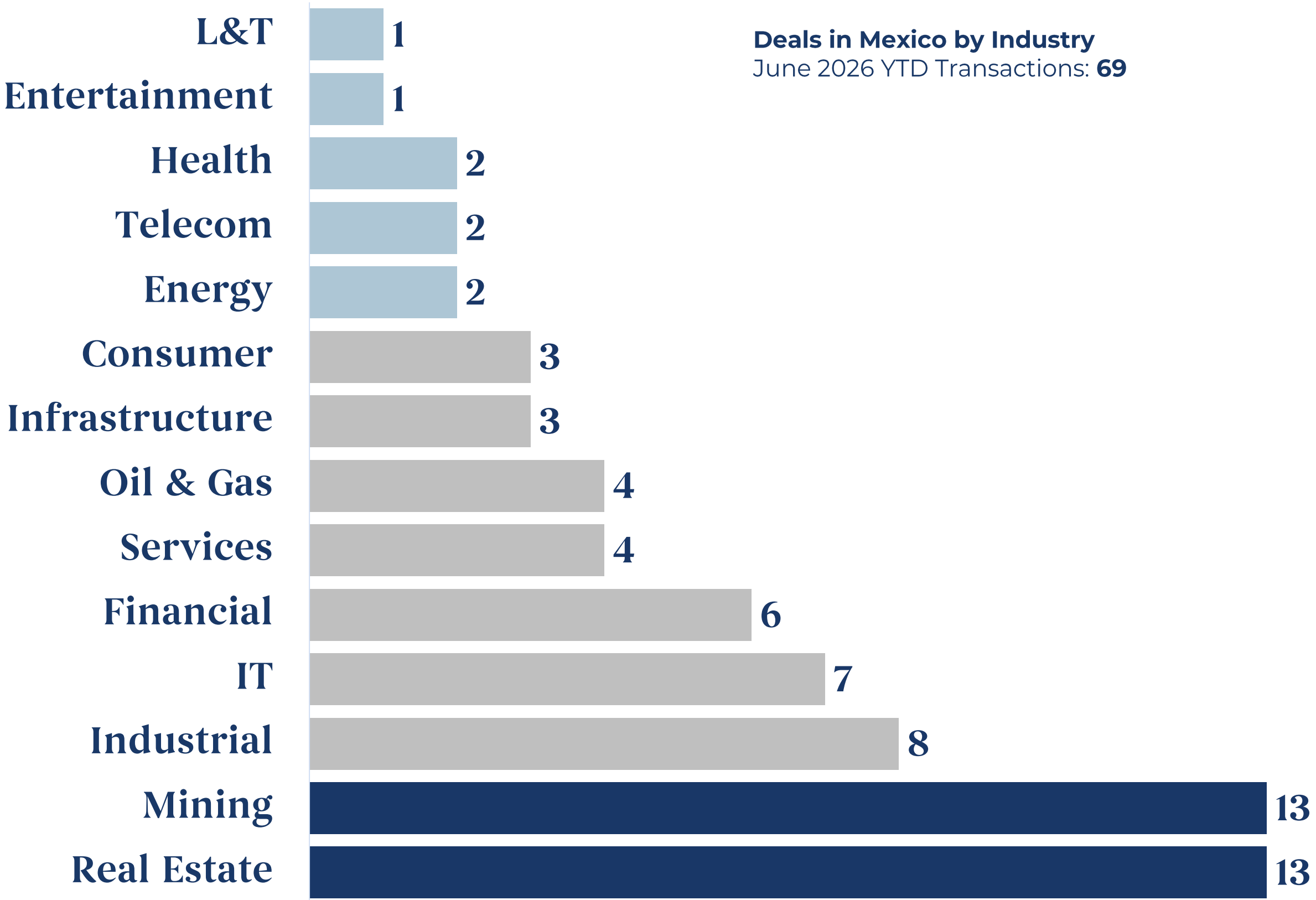


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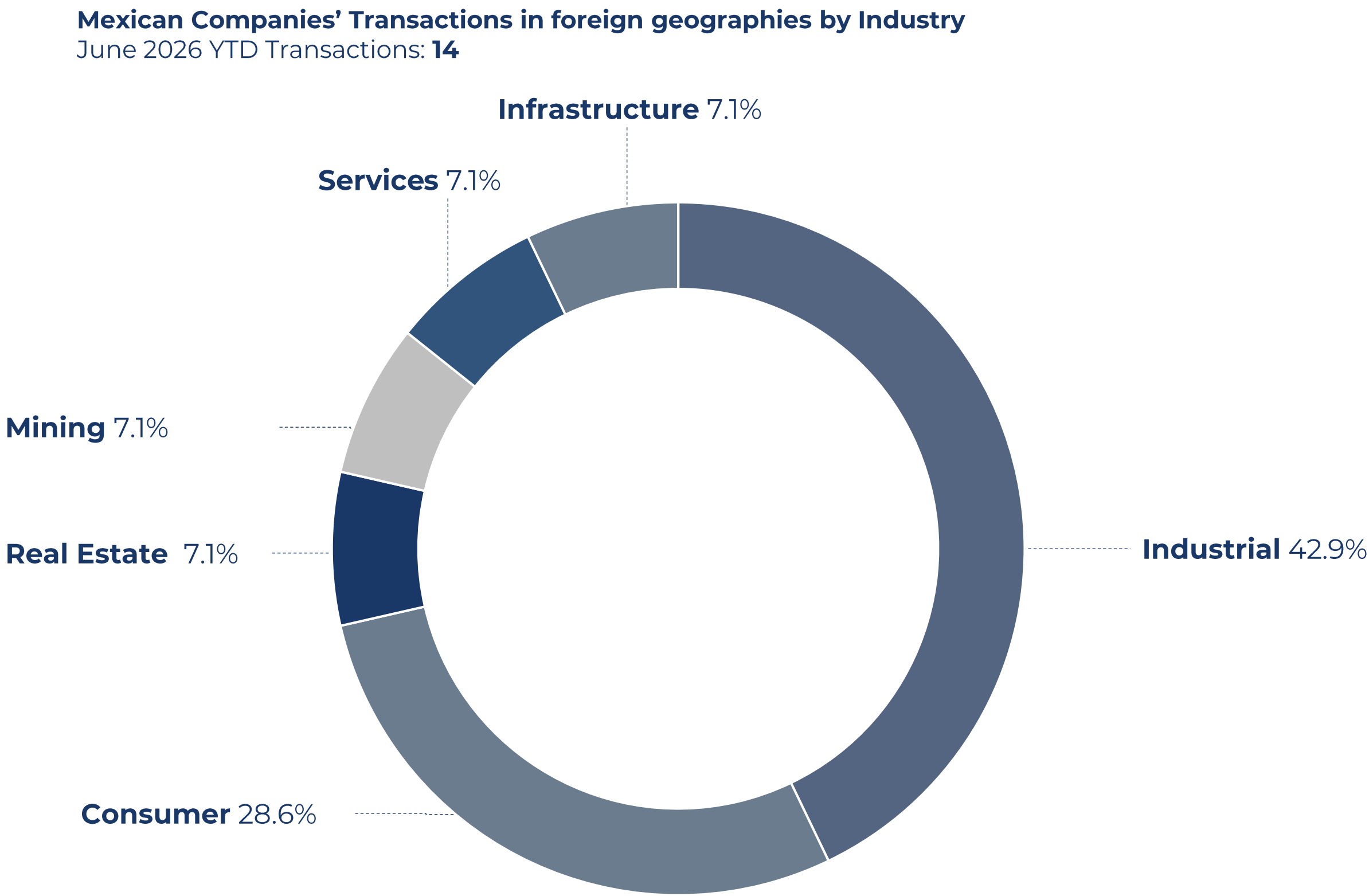

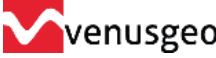
