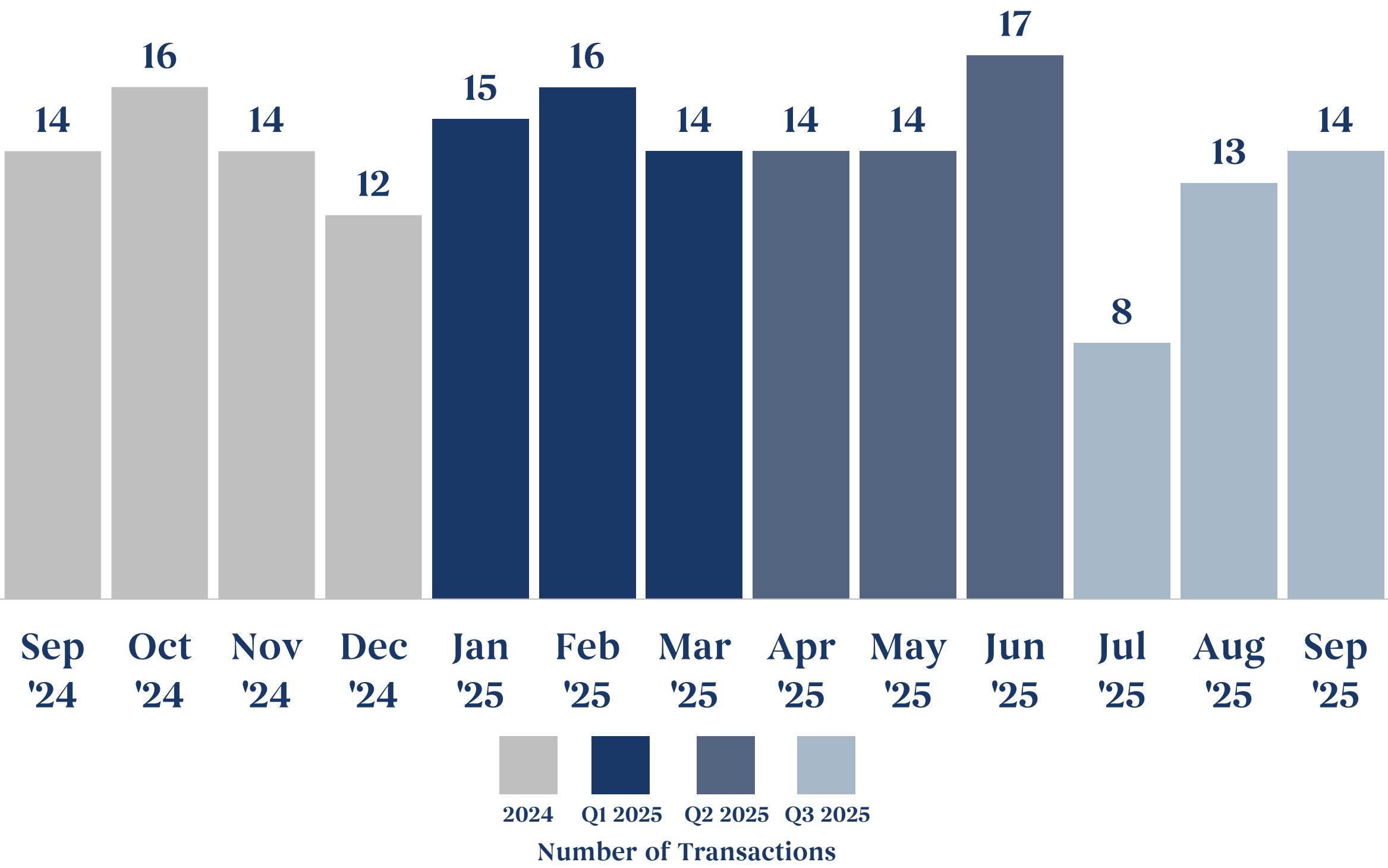

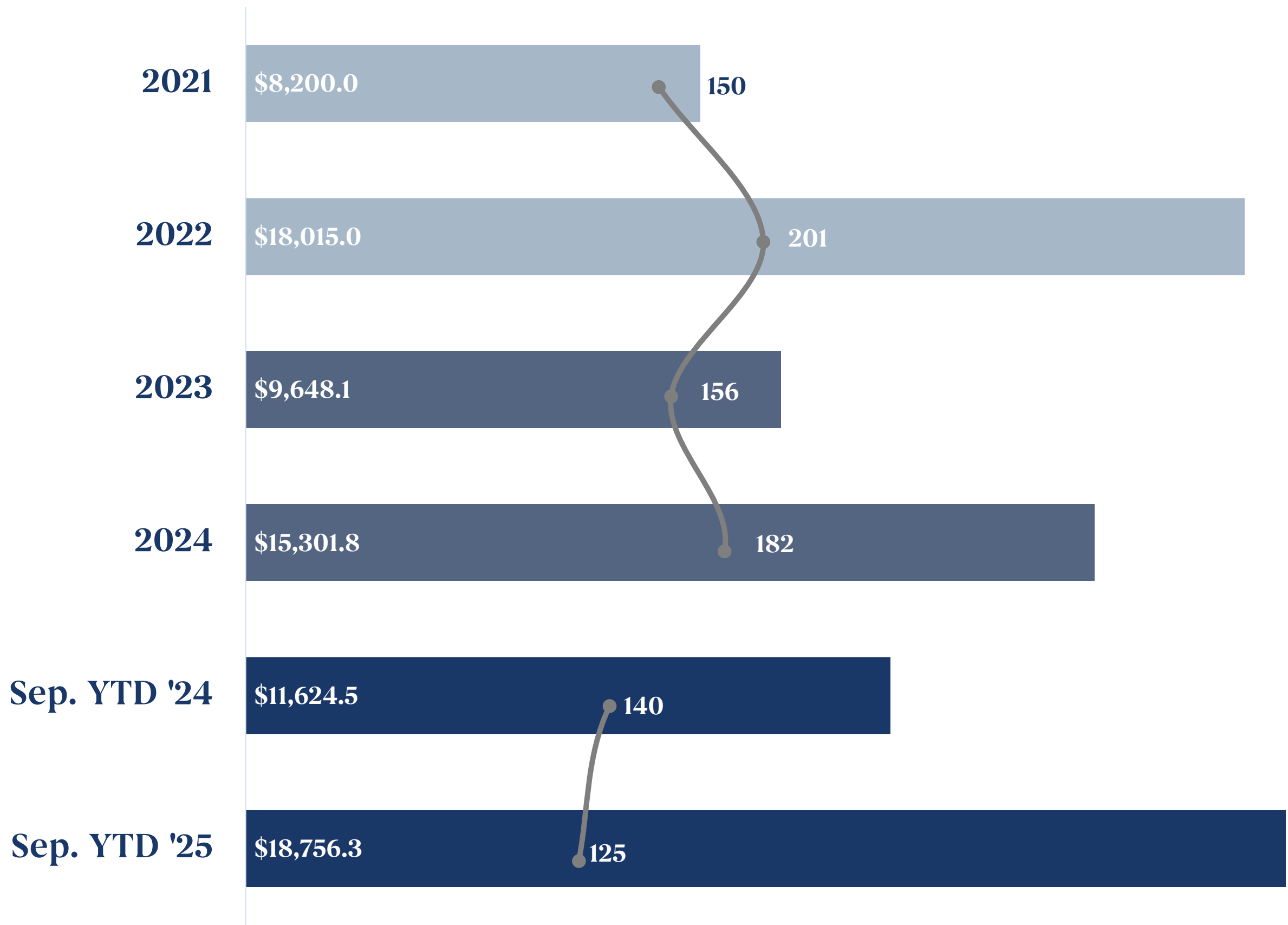
Disclosed Deal Volume in Mexico

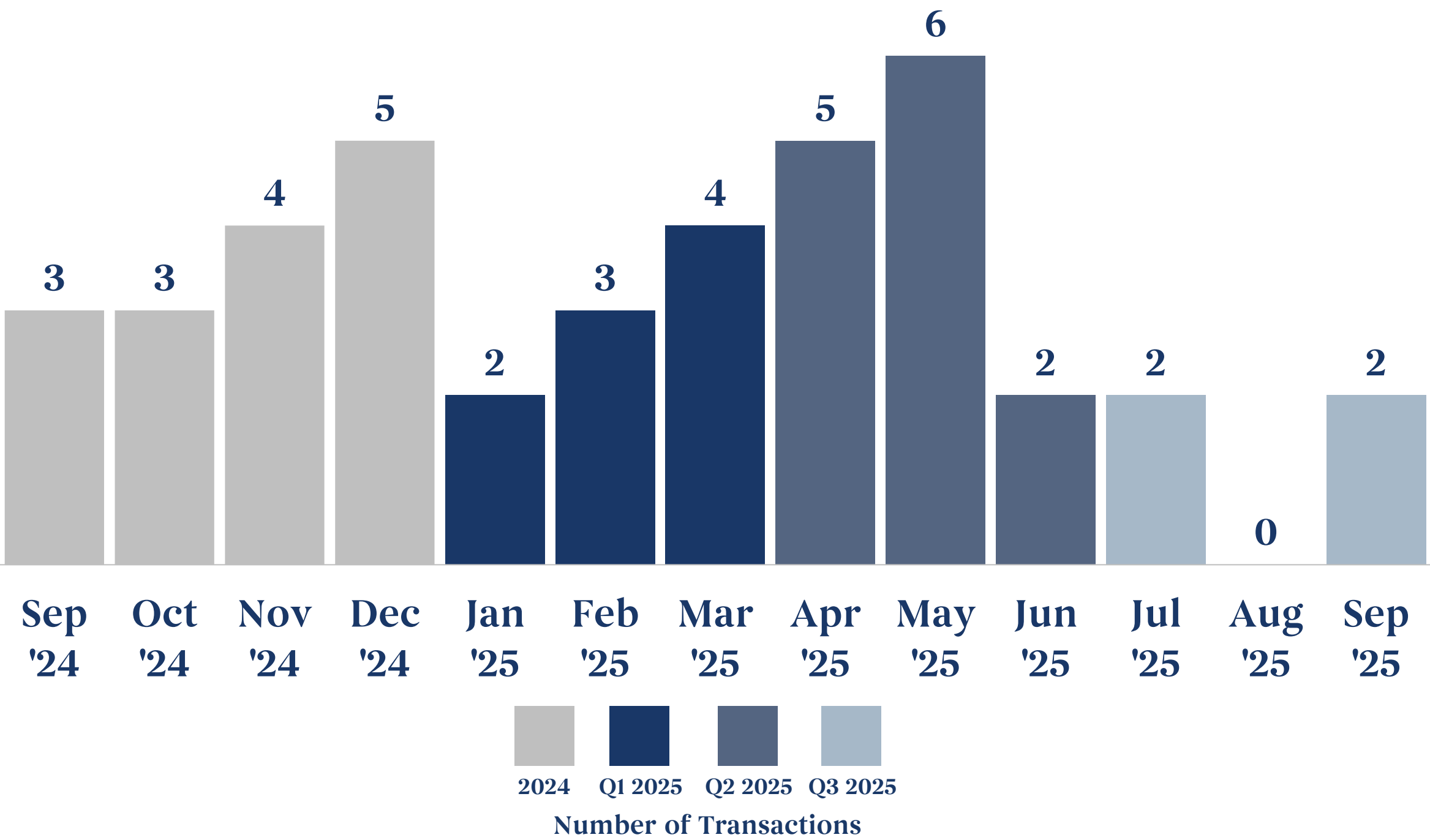
Disclosed Deal Volume and Value in Mexico

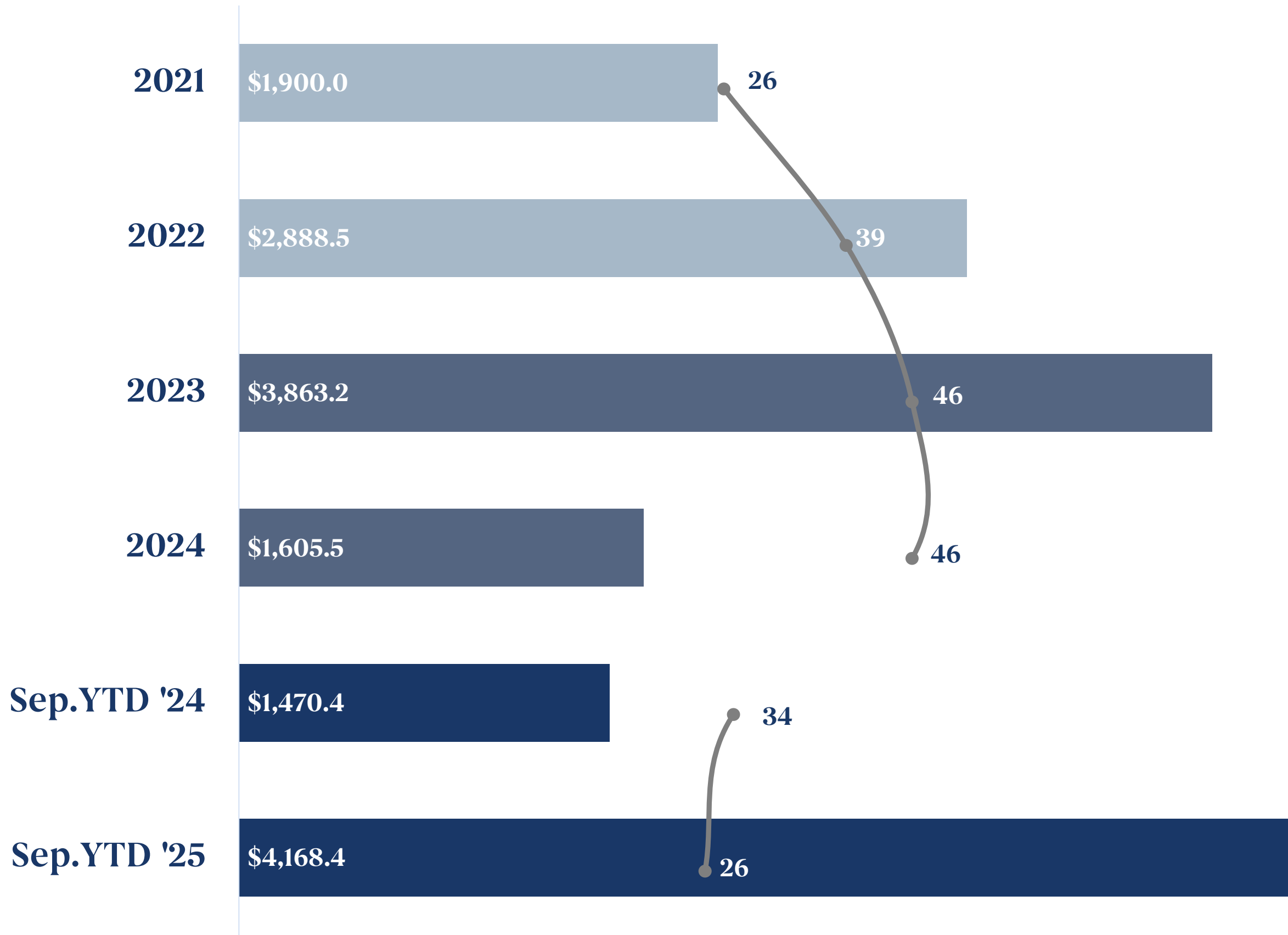
Disclosed Deal Volume by Mexican Companies in Foreign Geographies
of Transactions per Month



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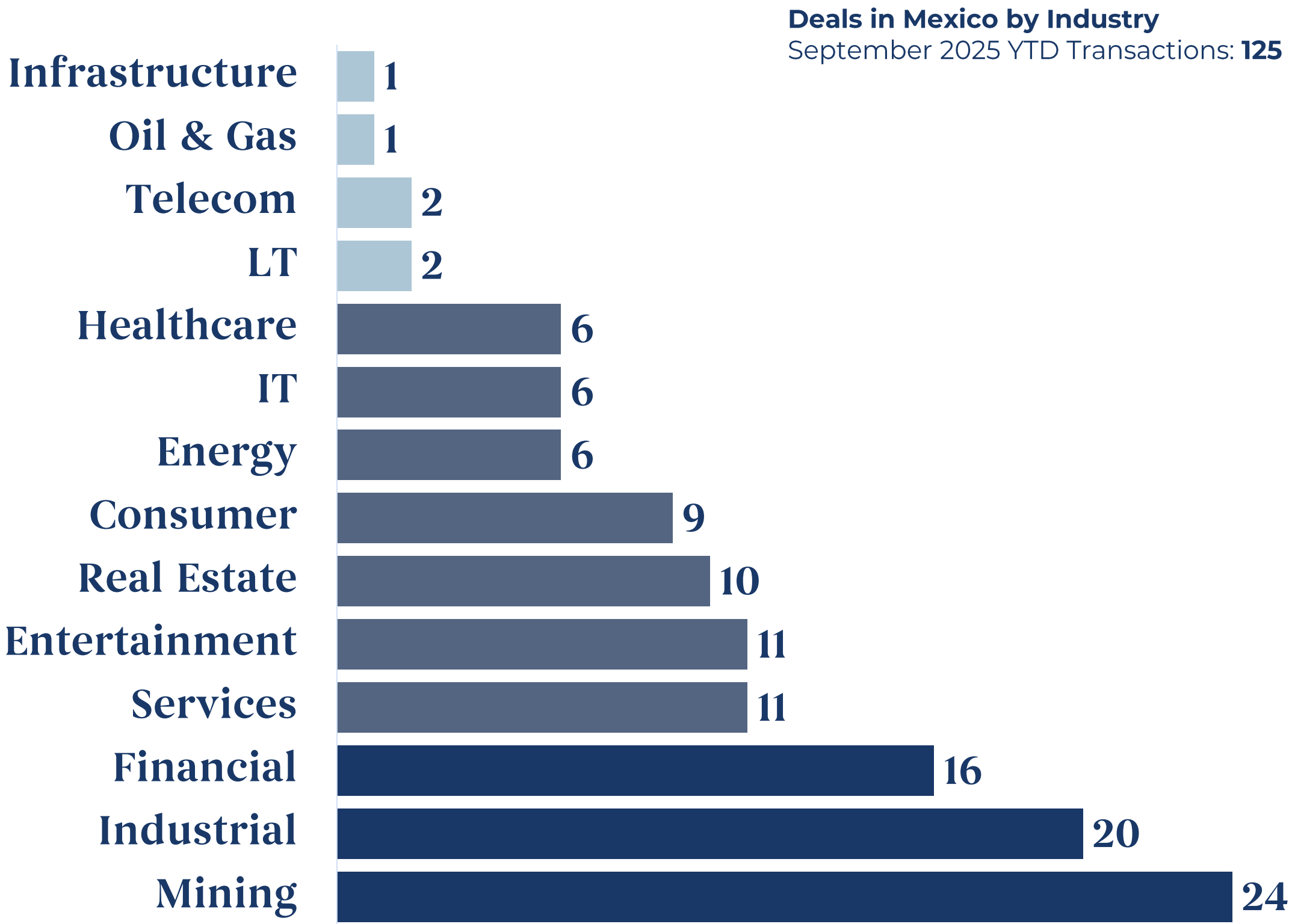

Annual Transactions (US\$ million)

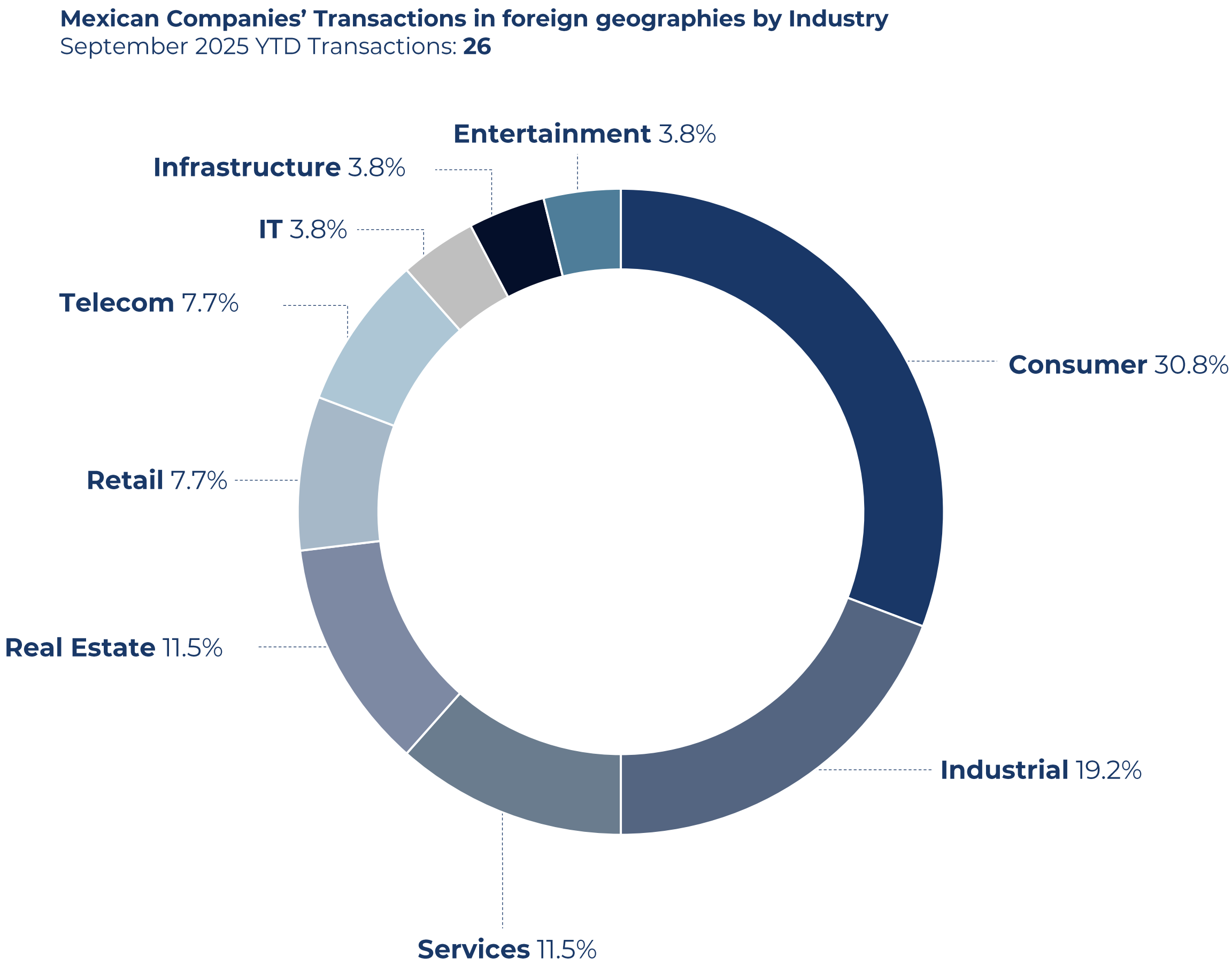


Summary of Mergers & Acquisitions by Industry

The **consumer** sector led M&A activity by Mexican companies in foreign geographies, with **8 transactions** as of September 2025, representing **30.8%** of the total announced transactions.

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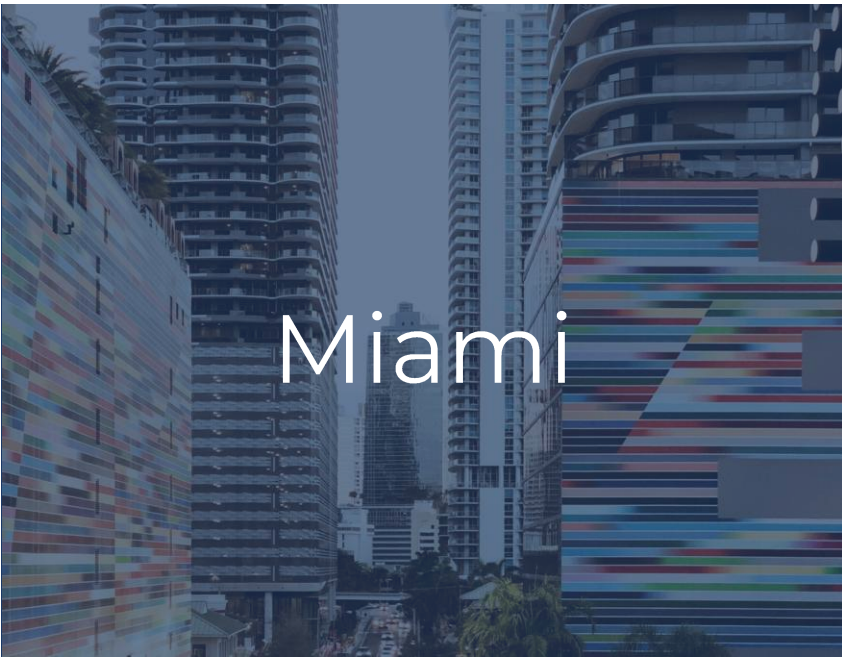
